

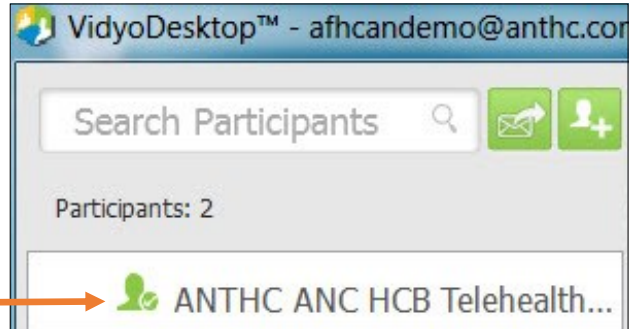
Far End Camera Control is possible during a Vidyo call only if the far side is using a Pan-Tilt-Zoom style camera. This document describes how to tell if Far End Camera Control is available and how to use it when the option is present.

How to Determine if a Vidyo call participant has a camera that supports Far End Camera Control:

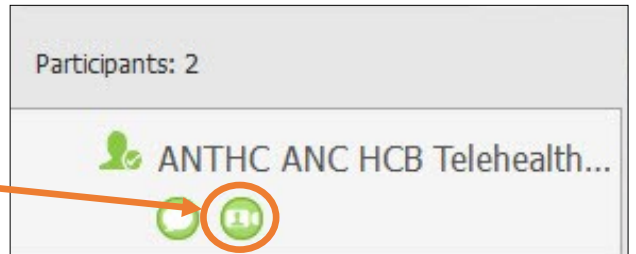
- From inside the Vidyo call make sure the Participants menu is turned on.



- From the Participants menu select the participant whose camera you'd like to adjust (let them know you are moving their camera).

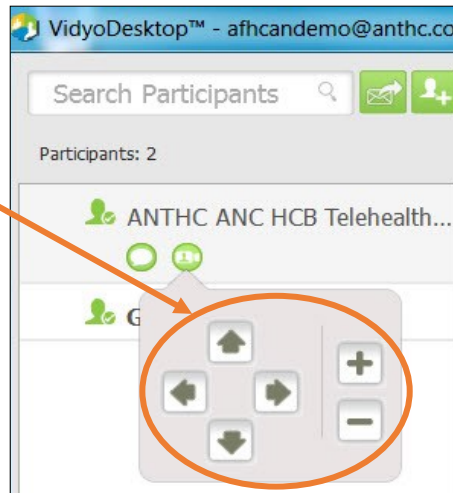


- Click on the Participant's camera icon.



- If the participant's camera has Far End Camera Control capabilities a directional menu and zoom in/zoom out menu will appear. Use these buttons to control it.

If Far End Camera Control capabilities are not present, this menu will not appear.



Note: there may be a slight delay when moving their camera

Near End Camera Control with a Pan-Tilt-Zoom Camera

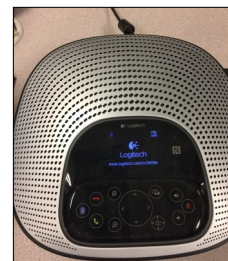
To operate a Pan-Tilt-Zoom camera on your own side (near end), use the camera remote, the Vidyo room system remote, or the controls in the Logitech Speaker system.
